## ***TFM* Announces 2007 Facility Executive of the Year**

---

TINTON FALLS, NJ – December 18, 2006 – *Today's Facility Manager (TFM)*, the leading facility management publication, announced today that William Coleman, associate vice president for facilities, Edinboro University of Pennsylvania, has been selected as the 2007 Facility Executive of the Year.

Coleman is being recognized for creating a cost-efficient, environmentally friendly, and visually pleasing campus for nearly 8,000 students and 800 faculty and staff at Edinboro University in northwestern Pennsylvania. In 1996, Coleman embarked upon an ambitious building program involving 20 campus projects at the 150-year-old university. These projects included 193,135 square feet in new building construction involving four structures; 457,117 square feet of building renovations involving 12 structures; and four separate campus-wide infrastructure, technology, beautification, and deferred maintenance endeavors. The total cost was \$83 million, not including a \$23 million renovation of an existing 90,631-square-foot building currently in design phase. Notable is the \$3.1 million renovation of 150-year-old Academy Hall, the oldest former Normal School building in Pennsylvania, and possibly the oldest building of its kind in the nation. Dr. Frank G. Pogue, president, Edinboro University of Pennsylvania, nominated Coleman.

“Mr. Coleman’s facilities expertise, combined with his untiring dedication to accomplishing the university’s goals and objectives, has resulted in facilities management providing a safe, cost-effective, energy efficient, user-friendly, handicapped accessible environment and a campus that remains one of the most aesthetically pleasing in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania,” said Pogue.

*TFM’s* Facility Executive of the Year award recognizes outstanding professionalism and performance in the field of facility management. Entries were submitted from small and large organizations representing industries such as health care, education, retail, government, finance, and manufacturing.

“This award recognizes facility managers’ commitment to their profession,” said Heidi Schwartz, editor-in-chief, *TFM*. “All of this year’s nominees deserve recognition for the hard work and ingenuity they devote to their work, but Coleman stood out. *TFM* is honored to present his accomplishments to other members of the facility management field.”

Facility Executive of the Year entries are reviewed by *TFM’s* distinguished panel of judges based on a five-tiered scoring system. The judges score entries according to how well the candidates demonstrate innovation, management, pro-business impact, human improvements, and sustainability through the course of a major project.
